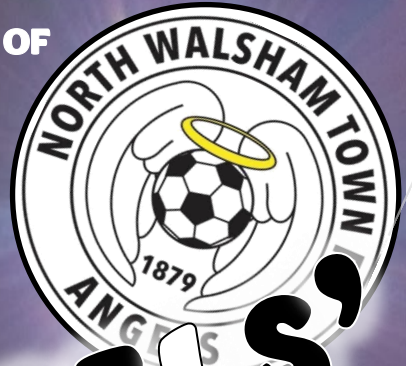

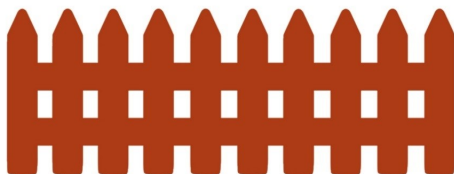
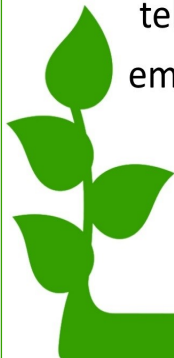

FIRST TEAM MATCH REPORT v MUNDFORD

NORTH WALSHAM TOWN 4 v 0 MUNDFORD

Town faced Munford hoping for 3 points to continue their good form. A great ball from Crosby gave Wilton the chance for an early goal and his finish didn't disappoint.

The next 35 minutes was not the best to watch but The Angels kept plugging away and could have had a couple more goals. In the 42nd minute a pin point cross from Studd found Wilton who again dispatched with ease.

On the stroke of half time good work on the right from Seago led to Wilton completing his hatty with the pick of the bunch.

The second half saw the defence determined to keep a clean sheet and a trademark long range rocket from Studd grazed the bar.

In the 74th minute a good through ball from King gave Gaskin the chance for his now customary goal which he took well.

A promising debut from Grimmer sealed a good 4-0 win. MOM Wilton, like fine wine.

FIRST TEAM COACHES REPORT v CAISTER

CAISTER 1 v 0 NORTH WALSHAM TOWN

North Walsham Town's push to keep pace with the pack chasing a top-three finish took a frustrating hit in the penultimate game of the season, falling to a narrow 1-0 defeat away at Caister.

It was a slow start from Town, but there were positives in possession on a tight pitch, moving the ball well in confined areas and forcing Caister to work.

Around 20 minutes in came the first major flashpoint, with strong appeals for a Town penalty waved away — a decision that helped keep the game goalless heading into the break.

Town came out sharply in the second half and enjoyed their best spell, creating several big chances and putting Caister under real pressure. Ultimately, Town were not able to convert those chances, and that would prove costly.

Moments later, Caister went up the other end in controversial fashion. A handball in the build-up appeared to go unseen, before a foul resulted in a penalty being awarded.

Despite protests and a general sense, even amongst the home side, of disbelief at the sequence of decisions, the spot kick stood and was converted to make it 1-0.

Town were then reduced to ten men for a sin bin, but continued to press and create openings.

Caister also went down to ten for the final stages, giving Town hope, but despite sustained pressure, they couldn't find the breakthrough.

An incredibly frustrating result, but positives to take, including a promising performance from Man of the Match Jaxson King. The Under -18 forward showed good movement and composure, using the ball well and consistently getting out of tight areas while still in control, causing Caister problems throughout.

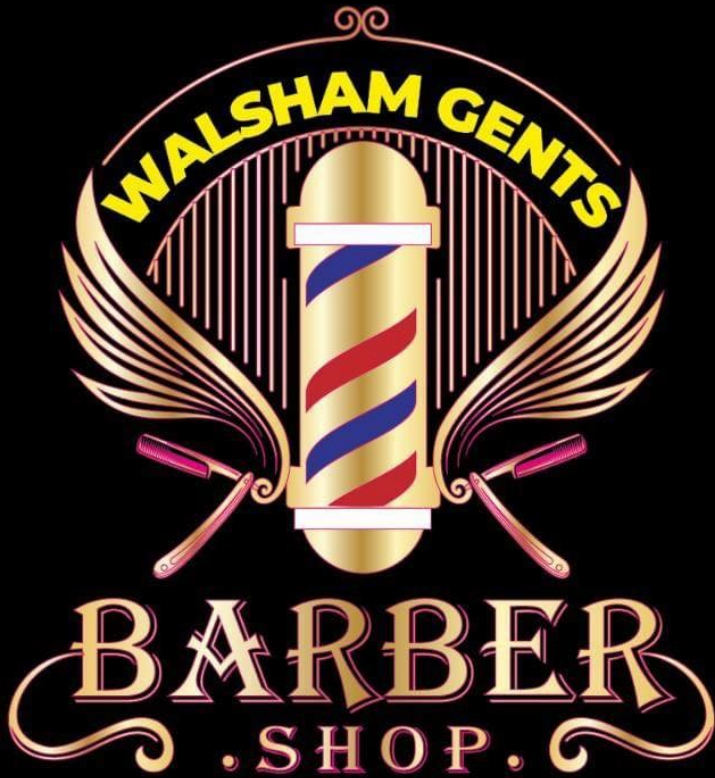

NORTH WALSHAM TOWN RESERVES 1 v 2 HOLT UNITED RESERVES

A Tuesday night under the lights saw the Reserves host Holt Res in the second of six games in nine days.

With a much-changed side due to the fixture pile-up, Walsham fielded a youthful back four of Feherty, Crane, Sayer and Orford – all aged 20 or under.

Walsham started slowly and took time to settle. The opening 15–20 minutes were scrappy, not helped by a dry, hard surface. The best early chance fell to Gaskin, but his effort was well saved.

A strong spell midway through the half saw Town gain a foothold, with Lloyd, Gray, Blanchflower and Crosby linking up well. However, against the run of play, Holt took the lead – a deflected effort looping over the keeper. Shortly after, the visitors doubled their advantage as Walsham failed to deal with a direct run, the ball falling kindly for a tidy finish.

Town went into the break 2–0 down in a game that could have looked very different.

The second half followed a similar pattern. Walsham worked hard but couldn't quite find their earlier rhythm. Blanchflower was a standout performer and earned a penalty after chasing down a loose ball and being brought down. McGilway stepped up to reduce the deficit from the spot.

A late push saw Walsham deliver balls into dangerous areas, but the final quality wasn't quite there to create clear chances. A competitive fixture as always, and credit to Holt who defended well and took their chances to run out 2–1 winners.

Second half was more of the same, the ball sprung down the left with Louie, who'd beat his man and was denied by the keeper but Grimmer was there to rifle in the rebound and give us a 2-0 lead.

A scramble in the Steamers goal lead to what we believed was our 3rd when Max bundled the ball into the goal, but the referee still being in the centre circle deemed the ball hadn't crossed the line.

Steamers pulled one back through a lofted through ball, that deflected off the biggest player on the pitch for the Ang Com Prem man to slot past Clayton.

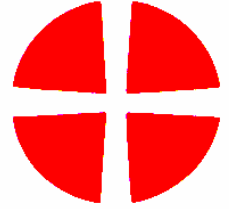

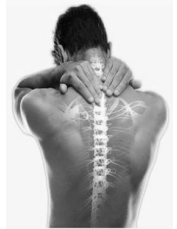

On & Around This Date In Football - 2nd May

1st May 1974

With the World Cup Finals in West Germany just a few weeks away - and England not part of it - the FA sacked Alf Ramsey as England manager. Appointed in 1963 he had managed England in 113 internationals of which they had won 69 and drawn 17 with his most notable achievement of course being the World Cup win in 1966. But failure to qualify for the finals of the Euros in 1972 and the World Cup in 1974 resulted in his downfall. With England due to play seven internationals in a little more than a month Coventry City manager Joe Mercer took temporary charge of the national team (3 wins, 3 draws and a defeat against Scotland) before Don Revie left Leeds United to become England boss in July 1974.

1st May 1980

The Arsenal v Liverpool FA Cup semi-final was finally decided – in the fourth match! In those pre-penalty-shootout days a 12th minute Brian Talbot goal gave Arsenal a 1-0 victory at Coventry's Highfield Road ground in the 3rd replay – the only time an FA Cup semi-final was played at that ground.

2nd May 1953

In one of the most memorable FA Cup Finals Blackpool beat Bolton Wanderers 4-3 at Wembley. It was known as the 'Matthews Final' as a 38-year-old Stanley Matthews at last won a club honour after previously being on the losing side in two FA Cup Finals - but it was close with Bolton being 3-1 up with less than 25 minutes remaining. The 'Mortensen Final' would have been a more appropriate title though with Matthews' team-mate Stan Mortensen scoring hat-trick. It was only the third hat-trick in an FA Cup Final - the first at Wembley with the other two coming in the finals of 1890 and 1894.

2nd May 2016

Chelsea 2 Tottenham Hotspur 2 – Spurs let a two-goal lead slip in the Premier League match with the dropped points seeing Leicester City crowned as Premier Division champions. Yes, unfashionable Leicester, 5000-1 outsiders at the start of the season, are League champions for the first time in their history. They went on to finish the season 10 points clear of second-placed Arsenal although that margin isn't really a true reflection of the title race. Leicester and Spurs were neck and neck going into the final few matches but while the Foxes were unbeaten in their last 12 matches Spurs didn't manage a win in their last four, a run which saw them pipped to the runners-up spot by their great rivals Arsenal. Leicester's success was widely seen as the most unlikely triumph in the history of team sport but just nine months later the architect of that triumph – manager Claudio Ranieri – had been sacked. Such is life!

3rd May 1980

Goalkeeper Bruce Grobbelaar scored the only goal in his League career – from the penalty spot for Crewe Alexandra against York City in Division 4.

3rd May 2014

Hamilton beat Morton 10-2 in the Scottish Championship. It was the first double figure score in the Scottish League since Rangers beat Raith Rovers 10-2 on 16th December 1967.
